Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

ENTRIES: Make checks payable to NWAHA and send to **manager** listed above (Nancy Thompson, 6725 W. Dry Creek Rd., Boise, ID, 83714). Use this entry form (attached) or download Entry Form B from the website www.idahodressageandeventing.org. All entries must be **postmarked** by the closing date; late entries will be accepted at the discretion of management. The show fills fast—classes filled by postmark on a first-come first-served basis. If the show is oversubscribed, entries postmarked by the closing date will be put in a lottery.

Training Level through Fourth Level will be filled first and Intro levels as space allows. Further information on this and any updates can be found at www.nwha.org.

All competitors required to volunteer 2 hours or pay \$25. Please indicate your preference on your entry form; if volunteering, you will be able to sign up for your hours when you pick up your show packet from the secretary.

SCRATCHES/REFUNDS: No refunds after closing date except with vet certificate and minus the \$10 office fee.

STABLING: Stabling required at Idaho Horse Park for each entry, even haul-ins. Stalls must be RESERVED through the Horse Park (www.idahohorsepark.com) and PAID for on your entry form. \$25/day per stall, including tack stalls *or* stay for the entire weekend at a special extended show weekend rate which covers Thursday through Sunday @ only \$85 per stall. There will be an Andalusian breed show taking place Saturday and Sunday with several classes open to horses of all breeds. For more information about the stabling facilities, please call (208) 442-3335. Initial bedding not provided. Shavings available for purchase and can be spread in your stall prior to arrival if you request this when you reserve your stalls. Permanent covered stalls with full doors available.

AWARDS: Ribbons first to fifth place. High Point and Reserve overall for show with additional High Point and Reserve for best score by IALHA registered horse. Championship/Reserve points will be average of two tests of the same level.

ARENAS: All tests will be ridden outdoors in 20x60 meter dressage arena with sand footing. Training Level may be ridden in a 20x40m arena if there are a high number of entries for those classes, except for the qualifying classes. Warmup: Outdoor arena 150' x 300', lungeing area 150' x 85', all sand.

TIMES: Official times will be posted at www.nwaha.org and in show office. **DO NOT CALL FOR TIMES.**

CONCESSIONS: A concession stand will be available in the spectator area of the dressage arenas throughout the competition.

FARRIER/VET: Farrier: Brian Jones (541) 337-1261. Vet: Idaho Equine Hospital 208-466-4613 (next to Horse Park). Numbers will be posted on show grounds.

NO SMOKING in stable area. All dogs on leashes, no dogs allowed in buildings. **Period.**

MINORS driving motorized vehicles must be licensed in their state of residence.

LODGING: Go to www.idahohorsepark.com for many listings. Hook-ups available for \$27 per night, must be purchased through Horse Park (208)442-3335. Will also be info at www.nwaha.org.

Day's Inn Nampa: Special rate of \$62.99 plus tax for 1 queen bed including continental breakfast, hot tub and indoor pool at the Days Inn Nampa, 2.5 miles from Idaho Horse Park. You must call 208-442-0800 and ask for Richard, the manager, and tell him you are in for the horse show. Rate not available by Internet or toll free number.

Hampton Inn: Right on the Horse Park grounds! \$99.00 + tax/night for 2 Queen beds or Standard King; \$109.00 + tax/night for King Suite – 20 rooms being held at this price until May 29th. Mention ANDALUSIAN SHOW to get this rate. (208) 442-0036

DIRECTIONS: Approximately ½ hour drive from Oregon border. I-84 to exit 38, Garrity exit, in Nampa, Idaho. North on Garrity, through a set of lights and turn right before the railroad tracks. Check in at the Idaho Horse Park Office on the right before you drive through to the stabling area.

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaultor, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and EV113, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while **WARNING** that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and **AGREE** to all of the above provisions and **AGREE** to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.
